Celebrate your child's birthday by helping build and maintain the Santa Rita Library Collection!

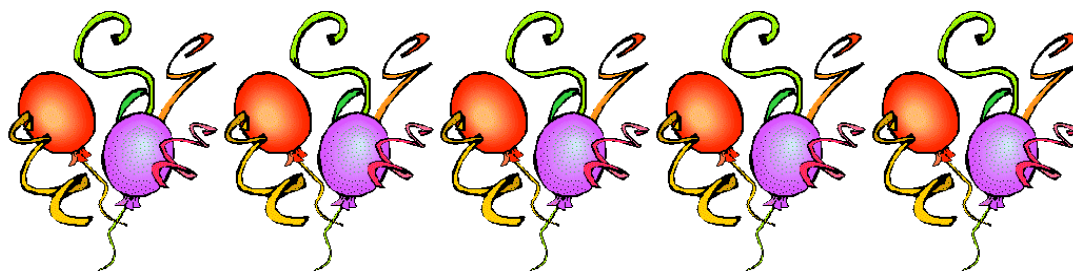
Our library's 2011-2012 Birthday Book Program offers a way to enrich our school while recognizing your child's special day. During a class visit to the library in his or her birthday month, the book will be formally presented as a gift to the library from your child. At that time, your son or daughter will be the first person invited to check out the book. A picture will also be taken for the Library's Birthday Book bulletin board. Children with July and August birthdays will be recognized in the month of their "half-birthday".
