Welcome to Santa Rita 49<sup>th</sup> Annual Witches Delight Spooky Silent Auction! Remember that all donations are tax deductible and 100% of the proceeds will be given to the Santa Rita PTA.

## Rules & Info

**Bidding.** All bidding will occur during the Auction at Witches Delight. To bid in the Silent Auction, write your name, bid number and bid amount on the bid sheet. Each bid sheet states the minimum bid for the item and each new bid must be in the specified bidding increment or higher. Bid amounts may not be altered and once a bid is entered it may not be removed. When an auction table is closed (closing times are indicated at each table and on each bid sheet), no more bids will be accepted for the items on that table.

The highest bid made on an item during the Silent Auction represents a legal contract to purchase that item. Multiple bidders, as indicated in their description, can win certain items, and each qualifying bidder is committed to purchase the item. All sales are final. There will be no exchanges or refunds.

**Item Pick Up.** Items won will be available for pick-up at the end of Witches Delight.

**Values.** Values listed for auction items are only estimates made by donors and are not warranted by Santa Rita Elementary School for tax purposes or for general evaluation. All items are sold "as is" in their current physical condition.

**Payment.** All payments are due to the Santa Rita office NO LATER than Friday, November 6<sup>th</sup>.
